	<p>14.2 Weekly planning lists from EDC</p> <p>The following application has been GRANTED</p> <p>14.3 DA/21/01721/FUL 67 Beacon Drive Bean Kent DA2 8BE Erection of a single storey front extension to porch to full width of dwelling, upgraded cladding, windows and sliding door to rear; Render finish to brick.</p> <p>14.4 DBC/20/00797 31A School Lane Non-compliance matter (refer Item 14.2 September 2021 Minutes, page 1785) Council raised the initial query with DBC regarding non-compliance on 26 August 2021 and followed up on 5 January 2022. A response was received on 6th January advising that the delay in responding was due to workload pressures and will be looked into and an update given when further information available.</p>	
15	<p><u>Highways</u></p> <p>15.1 Proposed crossing, Southfleet Road for school children to access Pedestrian access to Beacon Woods via the new steps. The bid was successfully delivered on 20th December and a decision is expected at the end of January. The results from traffic survey are due back w/c 10 January</p> <p>15.2 Designated Funds - NMU Improvements (For Approval) Approval required by 14th January Councillors had difficulties in opening all the documents but approved the improvements in principle. Councillors expressed disappointment that despite the Council's request the replacement gate in Sandy Lane has not been installed raising concerns that the lane may be used for fly-tipping.</p> <p>15.3 Zoom meeting with National Highways A2BE Roadworks The meeting which had been scheduled for 10th December was cancelled and was at 4pm on Thursday 16th December re-scheduled for 3pm on Friday 17th December. Unfortunately, due to the very short notice of this meeting BPC were unable to send a representative.</p> <p>15.4 Highways furniture Clerk to request removal of advertising boards on pavements and the redundant recycling sign opposite the Black Horse.</p>

17	<p><u>Footpaths</u></p> <p>17.1 The fingerpost for DR22 sited at Stonewood has been removed and left on the left-hand side towards Beacon Drive. PROW to be notified.</p>	

18	<p><u>Beacon Woods</u></p> <p>18.1 HE Landscaping project in Beacon Woods Works continue on the steps which is estimated to take 6-8 weeks. Contractors are now on site every day from 7.30am onwards.</p> <p>18.2 Damage to external fencing caused by vehicle On 29th November a vehicle left the road, crossed the verging and damaged a section of the external fencing. The Clerk has requested the insurance details of the driver from the police and is obtaining quotations for the repair. As of 4th January 2022, the police have yet to contact the Clerk.</p>	
19	<p><u>Recreation Facilities</u></p> <p>19.1 Fencing Fencing of the section adjacent to DR22 and the section adjacent to the High Street commenced on Monday 13th December. The fencing work has been completed but the gates are damaged and will either be repaired or replaced. Awaiting quote from contractor to fill in section between new fence and tarmac in toddler area. Instructions given to remove rubble (from old concrete posts) and to grind down visible rebar on some of the remains of the concrete posts.</p> <p>Youngsters are still climbing over the yellow gates and the new vehicular gates. Clerk to investigate installation of anti-climb rollers and anti-vandal paint.</p>	
20	<p><u>Bean Village Hall</u></p> <p>20.1 Meeting of Village Hall Working Party Meeting re-scheduled for Monday 7th February at 1pm.</p> <p>20.2 Village Halls week Village Halls Week will be taking place from 24 to 30 January this year. This is the fifth year of this celebration of all things village halls and is led by ACRE.</p>	
21	<p><u>Allotment Association</u> There were no matters to consider.</p>	
22	<p><u>Residents' Association</u></p> <p>22.1 The Association did not meet in January.</p>	
23	<p><u>Spirit's Rest</u> There have been problems with horses loose on the highway and horse welfare issues all over Dartford to which representatives from SR have been called to assist. Two events were held over the Christmas period and have also attended, together with donkeys, local nativity plays. Dartford Grammar School for Boys will be visiting for 5 hours later this week. Two PCSOs also attended.</p>
